

Orthotics and prosthetics is a \$3.4 billion dollar a year industry

•  
There are 350,000 amputees in the United States with 65,000 amputations performed each year

•  
22% of amputations are done as a result of trauma

•  
Lower limbs cost between \$10,000 and \$100,000 and are replaced every 1-4 years

•  
In Michigan in the year 2007, there were 708 work related amputations with over 90% of those being fingers

•  
A functional finger prosthesis can cost upwards of \$17,000 while a cosmetic finger prosthesis can range up to \$10,000
