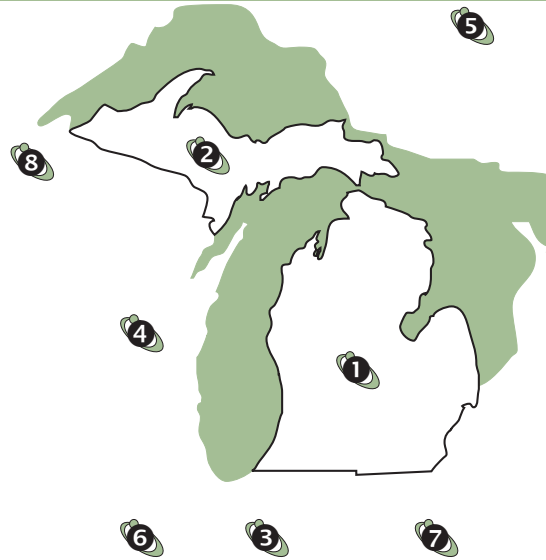

- Determine if short-term or permanent modifications are required for the home and client
- Contact pertinent members of the client's medical team to obtain plan of care, if needed
- Coordinate estimates from experienced contractors
- Offer recommendations for specialty equipment/products and assist in placement within the home
- Provide regular updates to the insurance company throughout the entire home modification process

### *As Directed by You*

- The OT will negotiate rates for all equipment, labor and supplies
- The CM will obtain physician orders and implement as appropriate
- File will be closed upon completion of the evaluation report or when no more intervention is needed as determined by adjuster

Collaboration by the OT and Case Manager reduces time and cost.
